

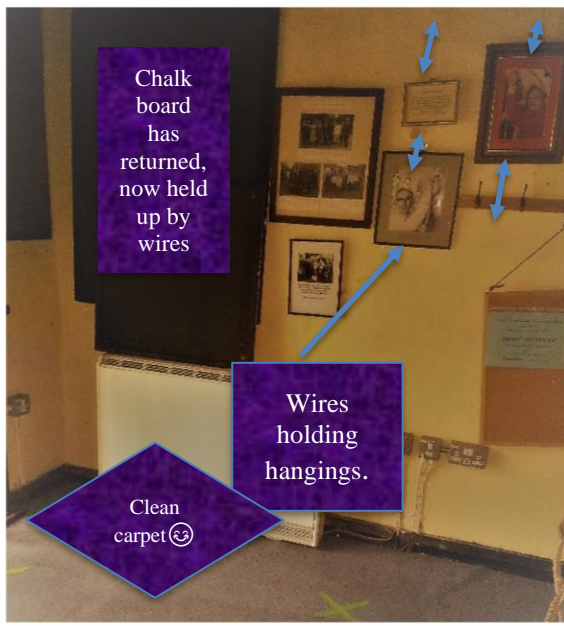

Welcome Improvements

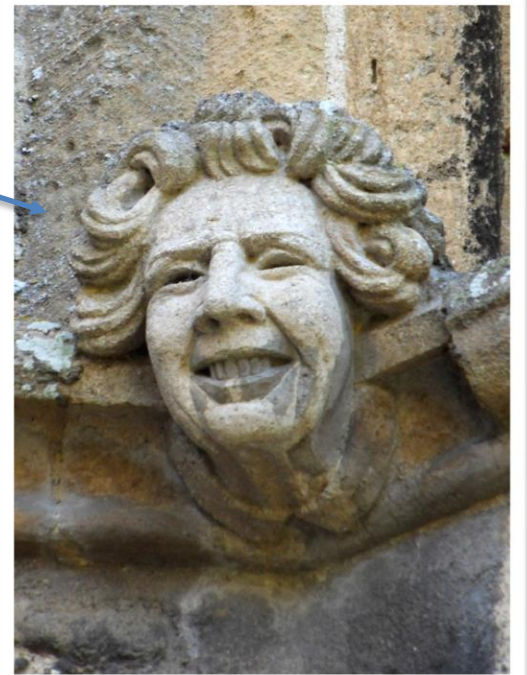
