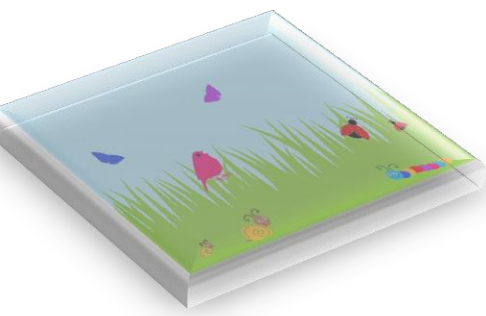
And...
