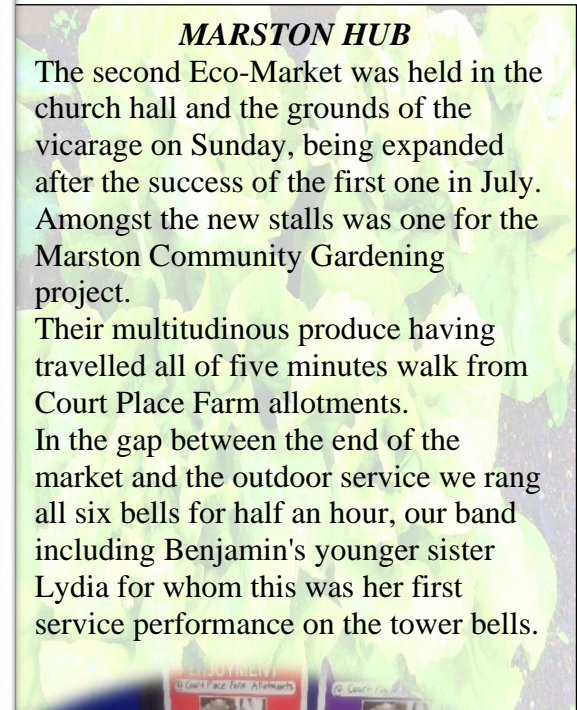


MARSTON HUB
